

SUSTAINABILITY AT THE SINGULAR PATAGONIA

At The Singular Patagonia, our sustainability philosophy is reflected in tangible actions across multiple areas, from energy efficiency to the conservation of local heritage and biodiversity. These initiatives aim to minimize our environmental impact while fostering a more responsible connection with our surroundings.



01. ENERGY EFFICIENCY

Digital Thermostats: Installed throughout the hotel, they allow for efficient climate control, optimizing energy consumption.

Key Card Room Controls: Room electricity automatically shuts off five minutes after the guest removes their key card, contributing to energy savings. (This system does not apply in the bar area.)



02. WATER MANAGEMENT

Towel and Linen Program: Guests can choose to reduce the frequency of linen and towel changes, which helps decrease water and detergent use, promoting a more responsible approach to water resources.

Reusable Bottles and Water Dispensers: We provide reusable bottles and have water dispensers throughout the hotel, encouraging guests to refill their bottles rather than purchasing single-use plastic.



03. WASTE REDUCTION

Refillable Glass Dispensers: Replacing single-use plastic containers in bath products, helping to eliminate a significant source of plastic waste.



04. SUSTAINABLE GASTRONOMY

Locally Sourced Meat: In some dishes, we prioritize meat from local animals, helping to manage populations and ensuring responsible practices.

Local and Seasonal Products: Our kitchen prioritizes locally grown vegetables and seasonal ingredients, reducing the carbon footprint associated with food transportation.

Organic Preparations: Our menu includes options that feature local and organic dishes, reflecting our commitment to sustainability and authentic gastronomy.



05. ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION AND EDUCATION

Beach Cleanups: We actively collaborate in keeping the nearby beaches clean, protecting the habitats of various local wildlife species.

Responsible Excursions: During excursions, we raise awareness among guests about the importance of keeping trails clean and not harming the ecosystem. Additionally, we engage in cleanup efforts as we explore the natural landscapes.
