At The Singular Santiago, our commitment to sustainability is reflected in a series of concrete actions integrated into our daily operations. These initiatives aim to minimize our environmental impact while promoting responsible practices.



ENERGY EFFICIENCY

Digital Thermostats: Enable precise climate control throughout the hotel, ensuring optimal energy use.

Double-Glazed Windows: Every room is equipped with double-glazed windows to enhance thermal efficiency and reduce noise pollution.

LED Lighting: All hotel spaces are illuminated with energy-efficient LED lighting, known for its low consumption and long lifespan.

Key Card Room Controls: Room electricity automatically turns off five minutes after the guest removes their key card.



WATER **MANAGEMENT**

Solar Panels: Used to heat water for guest rooms, significantly reducing gas consumption.

Automatic Irrigation System: Efficiently manages water usage in the hotel's landscaped areas.

Towel and Linen Program: Guests can opt out of daily linen and towel changes, helping conserve water and reduce detergent use.



WASTE REDUCTION

Refillable Glass Dispensers: Replace single-use plastic containers for bathroom amenities.

Reusable Laundry Bags: Made from durable materials to minimize waste.

Wooden Pencils: Provided in guest rooms as a sustainable alternative to plastic pens.

Glass and Cardboard Recycling: Collected weekly for recycling.

Office Paper Recycling: All paper waste from offices is recycled and donated to Fundación San José as part of the "Bota por mi Vida" campaign, which promotes tree conservation and waste reduction.

Donated Linens: Retired bed linens are donated to Fundación Camino for reuse



COLLABORATIVE AWARENESS

Bike Rack: Installed to encourage staff to commute by bicycle, fostering sustainable mobility.

Biodegradable Toilet Paper: Used in staff bathrooms to reduce environmental impact.



GUEST ENGAGEMENT

Towel and Linen Program: Guests are invited to actively participate in our sustainability efforts by choosing to reduce the frequency of linen and towel changes, conserving water and detergents.
